SALARY: Entry level is \$5,637-\$6230 plus benefit package.

POSITION & ESSENTIAL DUTIES: Under general direction the Engineer /Paramedic responds to emergency calls as both an Engineer and paramedic, drives and operates department vehicles and equipment, administers emergency medical aid, maintains department equipment and facilities, maintains records and reports, participates in physical activities, participates in training exercises, and performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Graduation from High School, GED Certificate or equivalent.
- California State Certified Firefighter-II and Driver/Operator I and II
- Possession of Company Officer 2-D Certification
- Possession of Valid California Driver's License, Class B or Class C Firefighter Exempt.
- Possession of an EMT-P license issued by the State of California and shall be accredited with North Coast E.M.S.
- Must possess strength and stamina with weight proportionate to height to perform job duties, including heavy lifting and carrying over 45 pounds, pushing, pulling, and climbing.
- Must be able to work in a variety of environmental conditions, including heat or cold, confined spaces, on ladders, on slippery/uneven surfaces, exposure to toxic chemicals, fumes, smokes, gases or solvents and other hazardous conditions.
- Must be able to utilize self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) while performing job duties.
- Normal color vision and visual acuity not less than 20/70 uncorrected and 20/30 corrected.
- Ability to work irregular hours, or long periods of time without relief, including but not limited to 24-hour shifts.

SELECTION PROCESS: The Lake County Fire Protection District will review all application packets. The most qualified applicants will be invited to participate in the selection process. The process will include, but not limited to a written engineer's exam, actual performance evaluations, and interviews. Applicants must successfully complete each phase of the selection process. Applicants who successfully complete all phases will be placed on an eligibility list for one year, extendable to two years by approval of the Board of Directors.
